serves as the chair of the church council, leads a team managing the weekly offering, and takes care of property maintenance such as mowing the church grounds and cemetery. Mr. Holmes selected the Jacksonville Lions Club as the recipient of ACNB Bank's \$1,000 contribution.

"I have known Tom for nine years and have come to appreciate his dedication and hard work -- not just for the Jacksonville Lions Club -- but also for his church and wounded veterans in our local community. Tom organizes the Lions Club's largest annual fundraiser, Bingo at the Walnut Bottom Fireman's Fair, recruiting volunteers and overseeing three evenings of Bingo. Four years ago, Tom recognized a need to provide off-street activities for the children in our community and arranged for the Lions Club and Trinity United Methodist Church in Walnut Bottom to sponsor a Trunk or Treat event in the parking lot of the church fellowship center. This event continues to grow each year," said George Hilsinger, Jacksonville Lions Club President.

"The Lion's Club plans to share the \$1,000 contribution from ACNB Bank with the local chapter of the Wounded Warrior Foundation and Trinity United Methodist Church. The remaining funds will be used for the Jacksonville Lions Club Easter Egg Hunt and the Student Scholars Program," he added.
